- Submit two (2) letters of recommendations. **ONE LETTER MUST BE FROM A SCHOOL ADMINISTRATOR, TEACHER, OR COACH.**
- Submit an official high school transcript.
- Be accepted by and enrolled full-time in an accredited four-year institution of higher learning for the Fall semester of the current school year. Official confirmation from the institution that you have actually enrolled for the fall term will be necessary before funds are paid to the institution.
- A 500-750 word essay on the following subject: **How can I help change the “quality of life” within my neighborhood by obtaining a college education and pursuing a career in Public Service (government), Economic Development (business/housing), Community Empowerment (organizing/advocacy) OR Neighborhood Revitalization (community and real estate development)?**

Note: Preference will be given to students residing in Wards 5, 6, & 7.
